

OCCUPATIONAL CODES

9	Higher executives, proprietors of large businesses and farms, and major professionals
	Examples: architects, commissioned military officers (majors, lieutenant commanders and above), corporate executives, dentists, engineers, financial managers, government officials, judges, lawyers, owners of large farms, physicians, professors, proprietors of large businesses and farms, scientists
8	Administrators, lesser professionals, proprietors of medium-sized businesses and farms
	Examples: accountants, administrators (schools, colleges, government) archivists, assessors, authors, clergy, commissioned military officers (lieutenants, captains, and equivalent), computer specialists, computer systems analysts, district managers, editors, librarians, pharmacists, pilots, production managers, registered nurses, teachers (secondary school)
7	Smaller business/farm owners, managers, minor professionals
	Examples: actors, appraisers, artists, designers, entertainers, insurance agents/adjusters/underwriters, office and building managers, purchasing agents and buyers, real estate agent, social workers, smaller business and farm owners, teachers (except college/university/secondary school), writers
6	Technicians, semiprofessionals, small business/farm owners
	Examples: air traffic controllers, dental hygienists, dietitians, foremen, inspectors, non-commissioned military officers (master sergeants, CPO), owners of small business and farms, sales manager, sales representative, secretaries, teacher's aide
5	Clerical and sales workers
	Examples: bank tellers, billing clerks, bookkeepers, cashiers, clerical assistants, dental assistants, library assistants
4	Skilled manual workers, craftsmen, tenant farmers
	Examples: bakers, carpenters, decorators, electricians, firemen, jewelers, machinists, mechanics, non-commissioned officers (below rank of master sergeant), plumbers, postal clerks, tailors
3	Machine operators and semiskilled workers
	Examples: assemblers, barbers, bus drivers, child care workers, deliverymen, enlisted members of military, file clerks, guard, hairdresser, health aides, housekeepers, mine operatives, painters, roofers, taxicab drivers, truck drivers
2	Unskilled workers
	Examples: bartenders, busboys, food service, laborers, waiters,
1	Farm laborers/menial service workers, welfare recipient
	Examples: attendants, maids, cleaners, dishwashers, farm laborers, janitors, unemployed and on public assistance
0	Homemaker; student; unemployed, not retired or receiving public assistance; unable to work due to injury/disability
